When she participated EMPOWERED's 2014 CCASTP in her neighbourhood, she felt thankful that healthcare was brought to her doorstep. 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When EMPOWERED volunteers arrived at her doorstep one day to break the news of positive Faecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT) result, she was devastated.
